Over the past decades, the Cathay Pacific HK International Races annual festival, has become the most important stop for horseman and owners from all across the globe. The event has become recognized as the 'Turf World Championships' offering excellent prize money and glory at the Sha Tin Racecourse in New Territories.

The festival comprises four International Group 1 events over different distances: CX Hong Kong Cup (2000m), CX Hong Kong Mile (1600m), CX Hong Kong Vase (2400m), CX Hong Kong Sprint (1200m).

## Sports For The Disabled

Hong Kong's disabled athletes made significant achievements in the 9th FESPIC Games. In 2006, athletes took part in the Far East and South Pacific Games for the Disabled in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and brought home 25 gold, 30 silver and 24 bronze medals, placing Hong Kong seventh in the list of 47 participating countries and territories in the medals tally.
