

## Island Beaches

### Cheung Chau Tung Wan Beach

This is the biggest and most popular beach in Cheung Chau. The beach sits across the narrow isthmus from Cheung Chau Harbor. It is five minutes' walk from the ferry across the easily explored island. Other beaches include those at Tai Kwai Wan and Tung Wan Tsai on the northern end. It was at this beach where the only Olympic champion in Hong Kong history, windsurfer 'San San', grew up and honed her skills.

### Lantau Beaches

#### Cheung Sha Beaches

On southern Lantau, with Upper Cheung Sha to the West, Lower Cheung Sha to the east. Very fine sand at Lower Cheung Sha and has open-air restaurants.

#### Silvermine Beach

Located in Lantau island, just beside Mui Wo

village and its ferry pier, it is nice and quiet especially on weekdays, but crowded in summer. Plenty of hiking trails.

### Pui O Beach

Pui O Beach on South Lantau runs along almost the entire shoreline of Pui O. The sand is a mixture of black and yellow. It has camping facilities.

### Lamma Hung Shing Ye Beach

This is along the most popular, well-maintained walkway in Lamma. The beach is long and clean and an adjacent path to it leads through hills and valleys.

### Lo So Shing Beach

Lo So Shing Beach is located on Lamma Island about halfway between the main villages of Yung Shue Wan and Sok Kwu wan. The water of the beach is clean and it is classified as a Grade 1 beach. Shower and refreshment facilities available.

## Water Sports Scheme - Leisure and Cultural Service Department



Encourages members of the public to enjoy water sports activity through participation, to help water sports lovers improve their skills and enhance awareness of water safety. Annual fee HK\$100 (April to March) and you must be able to swim 50m and be physically fit for water sports.

Centers provide training and rentals of water sports equipment (windsurfing gear, sailing dinghy, kayak, canoe).
