The Future Leaders Program selects a group of rising young professionals to focus on developing the skills and business connections they will need to achieve their full potential. Over 8 months, the course will provide exclusive access to the businesses and leaders that are driving Hong Kong's economy.

Future Leaders starts in April 2024 with a session welcoming them to the program and AmCham. Over the next 8 months, participants will have multiple opportunities for meaningful engagement with senior corporate, government, and non-profit executives to learn about new industries, what it takes to succeed, and how to overcome the inevitable challenges along the way. They will gain lifelong skills through C-suite conversations, behind-the-scenes industry tours, leadership workshops with leading university professors, and more. The program concludes with a graduation celebration attended by AmCham's Board of Governors, corporate sponsors, and program partners. The outcome will be:

- Young Leaders engaged with Hong Kong's community
- Business executives equipped for the future
- Professional networks expanded across sectors
- More entrepreneurial, creative mindsets

- Aged 35 or below
- At least 5 years of working experience
- Ready to take on new challenges
- Eager to understand Hong Kong's business community outside of their current work
- Curious and interested in developing new relationships across sectors
- Committed to attending all sessions throughout the 8-month program. The group will meet two to three times per month, generally in the evenings. There will be a few half-day training sessions and industry visits.

PROGRAM COSTS

HK\$20,000/participant, including the Program, mentorship with an AmCham Leader, a Hub Pass throughout the Program, and one-year Future Leader membership upon successful completion of the Program (i.e. attending a minimum of 70% of the sessions)

GRANTS / SCHOLARSHIPS

The following participants may apply for a scholarship:

- Young professionals who are currently working at a non-profit organization
- Anyone who has financial difficulties

How to apply: Candidates should tell us why you should be considered for the scholarship in your application form. Awardees are selected based on a variety of factors as the Grant Committee sees fit.

HOW TO APPLY
